

## GUEST INFORMATION



Conway Farms Golf Club opened for play on August 3, 1991. The Tom Fazio award-winning course sits on 209 acres in Lake Forest, Illinois and is designed around the traditions of Scottish links golf.

The origins of Conway Farms Golf Club trace back to three Lake Forest families whose love for golf was exceeded only by their foresight. Their vision for a first rank golf club began with the purchase in 1956 of a farm straddling a stretch of old Conway Road, thus giving rise to the name Conway Farms. Conway is dedicated to the protection and preservation of the game, encouraging walking, fast play and the strong support of amateur golf.

Over the years, Conway Farms Golf Club has been the home of the 1997 Men's NCAA Division I Championship, the 1998 U.S. Junior Championship and the 2002 AJGA Canon Cup. Conway Farms also hosted the 2006 Big Ten Championship and the 2006 AJGA Canon Cup. Golf Week ranks the golf course among the "Top 15" in Illinois.

### *Conway Farms Traditions Include:*

- A challenging golf course that offers a fair and enjoyable test of skills for golfers of all levels
  - Camaraderie, fellowship, and sportsmanship
    - No tee times
    - Fast play (4 hours for 18 holes)
  - Walking course including the use of caddies
  - Support of amateur golf

**Upon Arrival** - The golf bag drop off area is adjacent to the Pro Shop. Please identify your host so your golf clubs may be properly tagged.

**Lockers** - The Men's and Ladies' Locker Room entrance is marked and located at the north side of the clubhouse.

## DRESS

- Gentlemen are requested to remove their hats in the Clubhouse and when seated in the men's grill.
- Only traditional golf attire may be worn on the Club grounds.
- A collared shirt must be worn and shirts are to be tucked in at all times.
- Cargo shorts are strictly prohibited
- Only soft spikes are permitted.

## POLICIES

### *Tipping*

Tipping and extending gratuities to Club employees, including caddies is not an accepted practice.

### *Cellular Telephones*

The use of cellular telephones, PDA's and Blackberry's on the golf course or clubhouse grounds is also strictly prohibited.

## PACE OF PLAY

It is expected that you finish your round in 4 hours. Use these guidelines to assist you:

### *The TWO Minute Search*

Long rough is a feature of many holes at Conway Farms. So are lost balls. Accordingly, a ball should be declared lost after no more than TWO minutes of searching solely by the caddy and player of that ball, so pace will not be unduly delayed.

### *The Open Hole Rule*

When an entire hole opens up ahead of your match, you must ask a faster match behind you to play through. The match being waved through must accept the invitation.

### *Play "Ready Golf"*

Always be ready to play your next shot and don't be reluctant to hit or putt even when closer to the hole than other players. If you are ready, fire away, except if safety is in question. Establish the "Ready Golf" approach on the first tee with your fellow players.

### *Assist Your Caddy*

Advance the cause of fast play by anticipating situations, carry an extra club to your ball, or rake a bunker should the caddy be occupied elsewhere with your playing partner.
